

## **Boat Launching and Storage**

Dropping off, launching boats, mooring & parking boat trailers on Eildon Boat Club site will be available from Friday to Saturday. Communication via the intercom at the front gate to the office announcing your name & our club will allow entry. Leaving is automatic at the front gate. Retrieving your boat will be available up until Monday.



- Follow Sugarloaf Rd past the boat club to the ramp. Mooring jetty near the ramp
- Trailer parking is available near the ramp

- Marina #18 Pen21 will fit 2 boats
- Marina #19 has 3 empty pens 2 boats in each

## Eildon Accommodation Options for BMYs trip 6-8 Feb 2026

Option	Accommodation	Notes
1	<b>Eildon Lake Motel</b> – Tel: 5774 2800 or 0494 309672  See - <a href="#">Eildon Lake Motel</a>	12 rooms, half 1st floor accessible up stairs. All renovated in September. Have a local manager. Separate covered BBQ area with pizza oven & seating & pool. Double Queens & family rooms available. List price on corporate websites min \$149 double/night but local price when motel called direct is \$139 double/night and Manager Alan would offer \$10 room/night discount to BMYs members.  The Saturday night BBQ will be held at the Eildon Lake Motel.
2	<b>Eildon Parkview Motel</b> Tel: 1300 131 129 (or book online) See - <a href="#">Eildon Parkview</a>	Where many members have stayed before. Have a grassed area behind suitable for a club BBQ. Queen doubles, some with extra single bed plus family rooms available. Some sites are quoting rooms from \$200 double/night but if booked today rooms available from \$157 double/night
3	<b>Jerusalem Creek Marina Boatels</b> Tel: 5774 2585  See - <a href="#">Boatels</a>	2 six bed Boatels (1 with ensuite plus separate shower/toilet) and 2 four bed boatels available with local ramp launching and parking for Car & trailer nearby. All with own kitchen, living area, verandah with BBQ and ability to moor own boat(s). Walking distance to Store/ Restaurant/ Cafe/ Bar. Min 2-night stay. Approximately 10-15 minutes from Eildon township.
4	<b>Eildon Pondage Caravan Park Cabins</b> Tel: 5774 2105 See - <a href="#">Eildon Pondage</a>	Many Cabins sleeping 4-6 people, min 2 nights from \$140- over \$210 per night (Depending on how many staying per cabin). Large covered BBQ area with pizza oven & pool. Approximately 5 minutes from Eildon township but closest to Eildon Boat club.
5	<b>Eildon Breeze Caravan Park (not visited)</b> Tel: 5774 2567  See - <a href="#">Eildon Breeze</a>	Approximately 10 minutes from Eildon township. Cabins listed from \$149-194 per night. <b>NOTES:</b> Last trip Feb 2025 There were many cabins & motel rooms still available in early January but by the time the Club trip came around 21-23 Feb all motel units & cabins were fully booked and some members had to back track to Snobs Creek to get a room. The Eildon Boat Club provides free ramp facilities, mooring for boats & storage of boat trailers on site from Friday to Sunday or Monday if leaving later.
